WEATHER STATEMENT

PERIOD OF SNOW OR RAIN/SNOW MIX THIS EVENING...A FAST MOVING CLIPPER SYSTEM WILL ARRIVE FROM THE WEST THIS EVENING AND BRING A BATCH OF MAINLY LIGHT SNOW TO THE REGION. TEMPERATURES WILL HOVER NEAR OR SLIGHTLY ABOVE THE 32 DEGREE MARK DURING THE PRECIP SO THERE COULD BE SOME RAIN MIXED IN AS WELL. SNOW WILL LIKELY MELT ON ROADWAYS INITIALLY BUT WILL REFREEZE AS THE NIGHT PROGRESSES. SLUSHY COATINGS TO PERHAPS 0.5" OF SNOW WILL BE POSSIBLE BEFORE THE PRECIPITATION ENDS BEFORE MIDNIGHT. ANOTHER STORM IS BEING MONITORED FOR THE WED NIGHT – THURSDAY TIMEFRAME BUT THERE REMAINS A GREAT DEAL OF UNCERTAINTY IN THE TRACK AND IMPACTS.

Threat Window: 5 PM – 11 PM

Accumulation: Slushy Coating to 0.5" (Temperatures below freezing tonight will likely create icy spots)

TODAY	Mostly cloudy with a few late sprinkles or flurries	HI: 32-36
TONIGHT	Cloudy with periods of light snow early, possibly mixed with rain at times, ending by 11 PM, <i>Coatings to 0.5" Snow possible</i>	LO: 22-26
MONDAY	Partly sunny and a bit breezy	HI: 30-35
MON NIGHT	Mostly clear and cold	LO: 14-18
