ORDINANCE No. 1653

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 1629 OF THE BOROUGH OF STONE HARBOR SPECIFICALLY REMOVING THE POSITION OF RECREATION MANAGER AND REPLACING IT WITH RECREATION ASSISTANT AND FIXING THE SALARY RANGE FOR THE RECREATION ASSISTANT

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Stone Harbor, New Jersey, deems it to be in the best interest of the Borough of Stone Harbor to amend Ordinance No. 1629 relative to the salary range for the Recreation Assistant.

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Members of Council of the Borough of Stone Harbor, in the County of Cape May and State of New Jersey as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the salary and wage range, in the current salary ordinance regarding the Recreation Assistant shall hereby be amended to read follows:

MIN. MAX.

Recreation Assistant \$39,500 \$47,500

The Position of Recreation Manager is removed from the Ordinance.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Salaries, wages and compensation shall be paid in equal bi-weekly installments.

<u>Section 3.</u> The remainder of the ordinance shall remain effect as written. If any portion of this ordinance is determined to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, that determination shall have no effect upon the remainder of this Ordinance, which shall remain valid and operable.

<u>Section 4</u>. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies only, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 5</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 114th STREET WASTEWATER PUMP STATION REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(gg) provides public bidding exceptions when the subject matter of the contract consists of a contract for the designing, financing, construction, operation, or maintenance, or any combination thereof, of a wastewater treatment system as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15(19); and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council previously discussed and invoked the "gg" provision and directed DeBlasio and Associates to bid the project to three qualified bidders; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received by DeBlasio and Associates on August 9, 2023 for the aforementioned project in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by DeBlasio and Associates, the Borough Engineer, bearing project number SH-C-009, which plans and specifications are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference, all in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Fred M. Schiavone Construction, Inc., P. O. Box 416 Malaga, New Jersey 08328 submitted the lowest responsible and conforming bid in the amount of \$1,288,771 for the Base Bid plus Alternate No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has reviewed the bids and has recommended the contract be awarded to Fred M. Schiavone Construction, Inc. and the bid has been found to be responsible and in conformity by the Borough Solicitor; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough has determined that sufficient funds are available as evidenced by the Chief Financial Officer's Certification attached hereto, **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Stone Harbor in the County of Cape May, duly assembled in public session this 15th day of August 2023, as follows:

- 1. That the preamble of this Resolution is hereby incorporated herein by reference;
- 2. That the Contract for the aforementioned project bearing DeBlasio and Associates Project Number SH-C-009 and the same is hereby awarded Fred M. Schiavone Construction, Inc. in the mount of \$1,288,771.00 including the Base Bid and Alternate No. 1;
- 3. That Mayor and Council are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Contract for same in accordance with the bid submitted and incorporated herein as stated above;
- 4. That the Borough Engineer is hereby directed and authorized to issue an appropriate Notice of Award and Notice to Proceed as called for within the Contract;
- 5. That the Borough Deputy Clerk is authorized to return the bonds to the unsuccessful bidders.
