

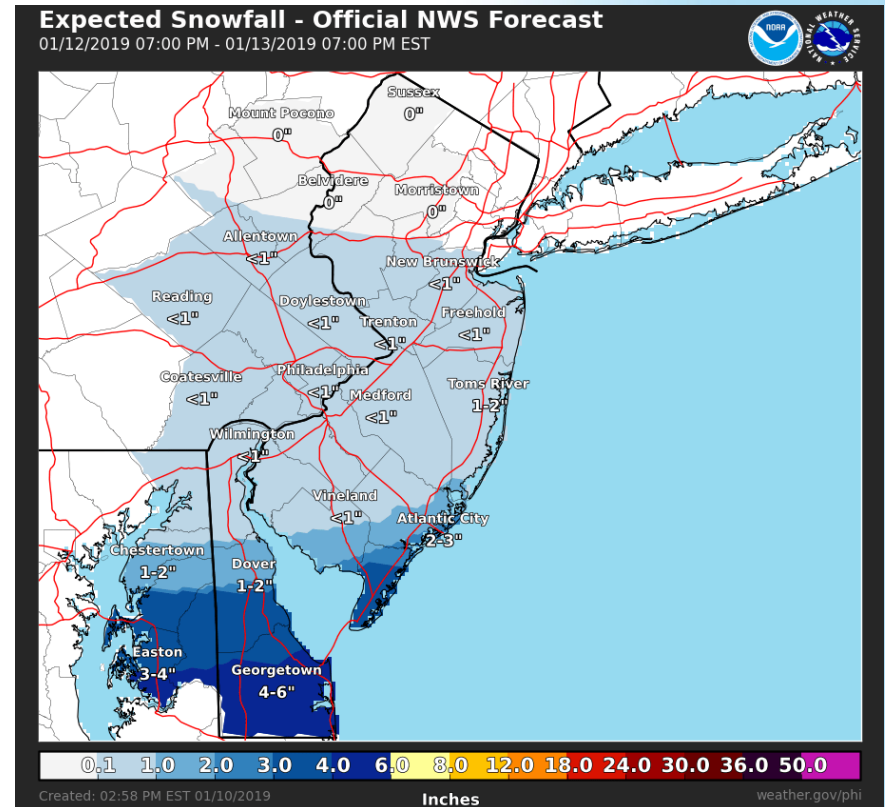

<p>Snow</p> 	<p>Hazardous travel conditions are expected to develop. Roadways may become snow covered.</p>	<p>A light snow is anticipated for southeastern Pennsylvania and northern and central New Jersey. Several inches of snow may fall in northeastern Maryland, Delaware and southern New Jersey.</p>	<p>Snow is forecast to begin moving into the region from the west late on Saturday. The snow is expected to continue on Saturday night and into Sunday.</p>
<p>Marine</p> 	<p>Northeast to north gale force wind gusts are possible.</p>	<p>The coastal waters of New Jersey and Delaware, as well as Delaware Bay.</p>	<p>Sunday into Sunday night.</p>

Summary of Greatest Impacts

 **Snow: Mainly northeast MD, DE and south NJ**

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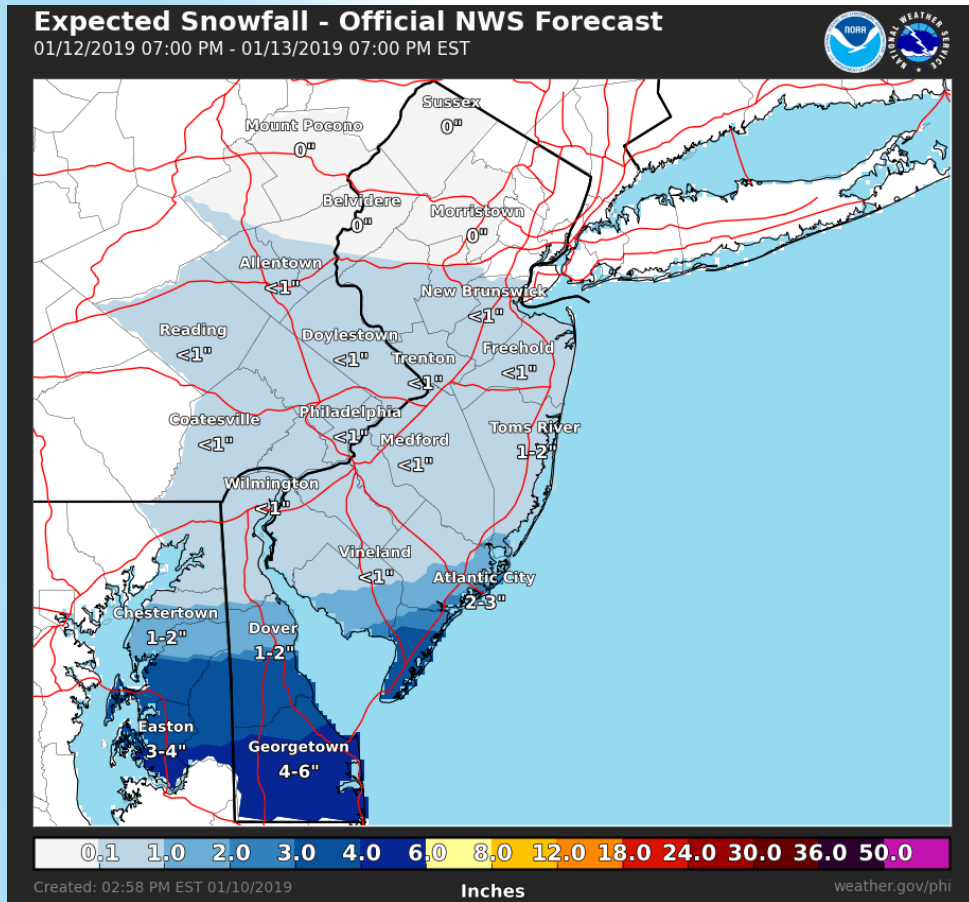


 **Marine: Coastal waters of NJ/DE and Del Bay**

Uncertainty in Snowfall Forecast:

- ✓ Confidence is moderate.
- ✓ A change in the storm track could affect snowfall totals.

Event Summary

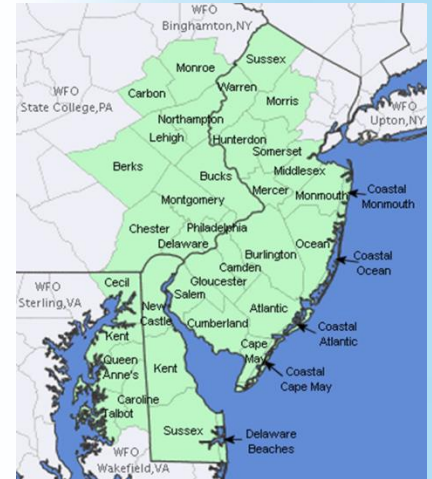
- ✓ Snow is expected for Saturday night into Sunday.
- ✓ A light snowfall is anticipated for southeastern Pennsylvania, and northern and central New Jersey, which should be on the northern fringe of the system.
- ✓ There is the potential for several inches of snow in northeastern Maryland, Delaware, and southern New Jersey.
- ✓ Gale force wind gusts are possible on the coastal waters of New Jersey and Delaware, and on Delaware Bay from Sunday into Sunday night.
- ✓ Coastal flooding is not expected to become an issue with this system.
