



What Has Changed?

✓ Initial briefing.











Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Snow	Hazardous travel conditions are expected to develop. Roadways may become snow covered.	A light snow is anticipated for southeastern Pennsylvania and northern and central New Jersey. Several inches of snow may fall in northeastern Maryland, Delaware and southern New Jersey.	Snow is forecast to begin moving into the region from the west late on Saturday. The snow is expected to continue on Saturday night and into Sunday.
Marine 90	Northeast to north gale force wind gusts are possible.	The coastal waters of New Jersey and Delaware, as well as Delaware Bay.	Sunday into Sunday night.





Summary of Greatest Impacts





Expected Snowfall Accumulations



Uncertainty in Snowfall Forecast:

- Confidence is moderate.
- ✓ A change in the storm track could affect snowfall totals.







Event Summary

- Snow is expected for Saturday night into Sunday.
- ✓ A light snowfall is anticipated for southeastern Pennsylvania, and northern and central New Jersey, which should be on the northern fringe of the system.
- ✓ There is the potential for several inches of snow in northeastern Maryland, Delaware, and southern New Jersey.
- ✓ Gale force wind gusts are possible on the coastal waters of New Jersey and Delaware, and on Delaware Bay from Sunday into Sunday night.
- ✓ Coastal flooding is not expected to become an issue with this system.
