## **Approval of September 18, 2017 Minutes**

Motion by Mayor Davies-Dunhour to admit the Meeting Minutes and seconded by Mr. Krafczek. Roll call was taken for members present at the September 18, 2017 meeting. Affirmative votes: Ms. Dubler, Mr. Hand and Mayor Davies-Dunhour.

## **Review and Discuss 2018 Planning Board Budget**

Board Members reviewed the 2018 draft Budget details and unexpended funds. A discussion took place regarding the funds to be allocated for professional fees, dues, legal advertising, and training. Mr. Bickford made a Motion to approve the Planning Board Budget for 2018 and Ms. Donnell seconded. Roll call was taken with all Members present voting in the affirmative.

## **Master Plan Review and Discussion**

Paul Kates of Mott Associates updated Board Members on the recent Master Plan Sub-Committee meeting held on October 4, 2017. A discussion took place on the topic of utility poles and how to best research timing and cost moving forward with Atlantic City Electric. Mr. Kates advised Atlantic City Electric has an active interest in developing new lines so this may be a good time to come up with a design standard and communicate with Atlantic City Electric. Based on the recommendation of Mott Associates, Board Members voted on Mott Associates completing a Utility Line Relocation Feasibility Study for the relocation of transmission lines recently installed along Dune Drive between 80<sup>th</sup> and 95<sup>th</sup> Streets. Motion made by Ms. Donnell and seconded by Mayor Davies-Dunhour. Roll call was taken with all Members present voting in the affirmative.

Board Members agreed that Mr. Catanese should prepare a draft Amendment to the current Ordinance allowing for swimming pools within 10 foot of the established bulkhead. Mrs. Gougher advised she will provide the Board with a copy of the completed Stockton Study regarding existing bulkheads around town once it becomes available.

Mr. Kates said the next Master Plan Review Sub-Committee meeting is scheduled for November 1, 2017. Longer term objectives will be discussed.
