



The Borough of Stone Harbor continues to utilize Code Red to maintain a “Reverse 911” system. This system allows the Borough to notify every residence that a flood or major storm is coming within 15 minutes of implementation.

A link to sign up for emergency information is located on the Borough website homepage. By following this link residents can provide the Borough with their contact information online which is automatically entered into the Code Red System. By signing up for Code Red residents will be able to receive all emergency notifications including flood and hurricane warnings. Residents can receive notification by landline, cell phone and e-mails.

The CodeRED system serves as the backbone of the Borough’s emergency planning and communications outreach to both citizens and Borough personnel by using the system capabilities to send telephone calls, text messages, emails and social media in an effort to effectively inform residents to protect life and property. CodeRED, among other notification systems available, was selected for its unrivalled reliability and accuracy, as well as the system’s global use.
