

## FLOOD PROTECTION INFORMATION

## **Mission Statement**

The safety of your family is of the utmost importance! To be well informed about an approaching storm, keep a battery powered radio tuned to a local station, and follow all emergency instructions. If evacuation is ordered, The Borough of Stone Harbor has a prepared emergency evacuation plan coordinated with the Cape May County Office of Emergency Management to assure the smooth flow of traffic off of the island. In the event of a storm advisory or warning, immediately bring outdoor furniture and other possessions inside or tie them down securely, be sure you have a full tank of gasoline and stock the car with nonperishable canned goods (with a can opener), a container of water, first aid kit and any special medication needed by the family. Do not walk through flowing water. Do not drive through flooded areas. Stay away from downed wires of any kind. If time permits, pull off the main power switch and shut off the main gas valve.
