Hello Marc;

We spoke last week about the replacement utility pole for the beach entrance on 98th in Stone Harbor. I have organized the homeowners on 98th and we are in the process of having the utility poles removed and the wires placed underground.

We prefer the shorter pole found on many beach entrances in Avalon, such as 76th street. Our contact at ACE, Ken Atwood stated the cost of the shorter decorative pole is anywhere between \$750 and \$3000. The taller, more obtrusive pole is what traditionally is used in Stone Harbor.

When we spoke you stated that permission to use the shorter pole must be secured from the Stone Harbor town council. My group of homeowners has two preliminary questions at this time: 1. Would there be a cost for an exemption or permission to associated with securing the council's approval and 2. Could this issue be raised at their next meeting as not to slow down our project? We have contracts with ACE, Verizon and Comcast executed and the work is scheduled to be completed by Spring. We would not wish to be delayed if it will take months for the council to address our request.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Stone Harbor in the County of Cape May and the State of New Jersey has ordained that certain fees may be established from time-to-time by Resolution of the Borough Council; and

WHEREAS, the Administration and Finance Committee of Borough Council has recommended that certain fees be established by Resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Borough Council of the Borough of Stone Harbor, in the County of Cape May, duly assembled in public session this 5th day of February, 2019, that the following fees be set at the following levels for the year 2019:

- Beach Fees
 - \$23.00 pre-season
 - \$28.00 after May 31, 2019
 - \$12.00 weekly
 - \$6.00 daily
- Newspaper Vending Permit \$65.00
- Floating Dock Storage \$250.00 per floating dock
- Sailcraft Permit \$250.00
- Municipal Boat Slip
 - \$1,700.00 slips 9-25
 - \$1,500.00 slips 26-79
- Boat Trailer Storage \$150.00 per trailer
- Peddlers/Solicitors/Vendors \$350.00
- Vehicles on Beach \$60.00
- Boat Ramp \$10.00 daily \$100.00 per season
- Business Registration
 - \$100.00
 - \$50.00 Late fee applied after July 1st
- Parking Permit \$225.00
- Kayak Permit No fee
- Taxi License \$100.00
- Vendors \$350.00
- Alcoholic Beverage License
 - \$2,500.00
 - \$188.00 Club
- Amusement License
 - \$300.00 annual (up to 3 machines)
 - Each additional machine \$30.00
- Cat & Dog Licenses
 - Dogs \$4.20 neutered
 - Dogs \$7.20 non-neutered
- Cats
 - Cats \$5.50 neutered
 - Cats \$50.00 non-neutered
- Parking Meters
 - .25 for 15 minutes
 - (with a 10 minute Grace Period)
 - Kiosk parking lots located at the Beach and the Water Tower will remain \$.25 for 30 minutes (no Grace Period)
 - Kiosk located at Beach will have hours limited to 10 am -- 5 pm
 - Kiosk located at Beach (Recreation Vehicle Spaces Only) will be .50 cents per 15 minutes 10am – 5 pm (no grace period)
 - The 2 – 1 cent meters next to Post Office
 - 5 cents for 12 minutes (no Grace Period)
