AFFORDABLE HOUSING ORDINANCE ORDINANCE NO. -2020

An Ordinance Repealing Chapter 560 (Affordable Housing) In The Code of the Borough of Stone Harbor In Its Entirety, And Replacing Same With A Chapter Entitled "Affordable Housing Regulations," Which Will Address The Requirements Of The Fair Housing Act And The Uniform Housing Affordability Controls (UHAC) Regarding Compliance With The Township's Affordable Housing Obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Stone Harbor, Cape May County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 560 (Affordable Housing) of the Code of the Borough of Stone Harbor is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

§560-48 - Affordable Housing.

A. Affordable Housing Obligations

- This section is intended to assure that very-low-, low-, and moderate-income units ("affordable units") are created with controls on affordability and that low- and moderate-income households shall occupy these units. This section shall apply except where inconsistent with applicable law.
- 2) The Borough of Stone Harbor Planning Board has adopted a Housing Element and Fair Share Plan pursuant to the Municipal Land Use Law at N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1, et seq. The Fair Share Plan has been adopted by the Planning Board and endorsed by the governing body. The Fair Share Plan describes how Stone Harbor Borough shall address its fair share for low- and moderate-income housing as documented in the Housing Element and outlined in the terms of the settlement agreement between the Borough and Fair Share Housing Center (FSHC).
- 3) This section implements the Borough's Fair Share Plan, addresses the requirements of the Court and the terms of the settlement agreement, and also implements a Borough-wide requirement that all new multifamily residential development of five or more units shall have a mandatory affordable housing set aside for low- and moderate-income units, subject to certain enumerated conditions.
- 4) The Borough of Stone Harbor shall track the status of the implementation of the Housing Element and Fair Share Plan. Any plan evaluation report of the Housing Element and Fair Share Plan shall be available to the public at Borough Hall located on 9508 Second Avenue, Stone Harbor, NJ 08247.
 - a. For the midpoint realistic opportunity review due on July 2, 2020, as required pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27D-313, the Borough will post its report on its website, with notice to all interested parties on or before that date.
 - b. For the review of very low-income housing requirements required by N.J.S.A. 52:27D-329.1, the Borough will post its report on its website with notice to all interested parties within three years of the Fairness Order, entered by the Court on January 23, 2018.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF CAPE MAY PERTAINING TO A RESCUE TASK FORCE FOR A TERM OF FIVE (5) YEARS

WHEREAS, the County of Cape May ("County") and the Borough of Stone Harbor ("Municipality") or Stone Harbor) are authorized to enter into a shared services agreement ("SSA") pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Ace ("USSCA"), N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 to 35, as amended and supplemented from time to time: and

WHEREAS, the County and the Municipality deem it to be in the interest of public safety for members of the Municipal Rescue Squad/Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") or certain members thereof who have expressed an interest in doing so, to receive certain specialized training in order to respond to a mass casualty involving high risk/critical incidents including those incidents that are terroristic in nature; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of such an objective, the County has applied for and received a grant from the New Jersey Office of Homeland Security ('NJDHS") which has or will enable the County to purchase certain ballistic equipment that will be made available to participating Municipalities and their respective Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") which will be used solely by the Municipal Rescue Squad/EMS in responding to a mass casualty involving a high risk/critical incident (hereafter "mass casualty") and

WHEREAS, The Cape May County Association of Chiefs of Police has developed a policy known as Standard Operating Procedure No. 56 (hereafter "SOP 56") and approved by the Cape May County Prosecutor under date of September 25, 2020 which, in pertinent part, provides that a Rescue Task Force ("RTF") is the integrated response of local EMS and Fire elements in support of Law Enforcement to an Active Shooter/Hostile Incident ("ASHI") attack with the potential for incident escalation (i.g. CBRNE, hostage, mass casualty, etc.) The primary goal of RTF is the rapid wound stabilization and rapid extraction of victims as defined in said SOP 56: and

WHEREAS, when responding to a mass casualty in the municipal jurisdiction, or elsewhere, the RTF will operate under the direction of Law Enforcement in the person of the Municipal Chief of Police or the Chief's designee; and

WHEREAS, the County is procuring the highly specialized equipment from reputable manufactures and/or vendors and will provide training in the use of such equipment to be offered by third-party persons, firms or entities with acknowledged skill and expertise in such matters which may include the manufacturer and/or vendor; and

WHEREAS, it is the expectation that such equipment will have a useful life of 5 years at which time it is to be returned to the County by the Municipality. The Municipality will then be expected to purchase replacement equipment at the Municipal's sole cost and expense; and

WHEREAS, the County has established a protocol for the use of such equipment and governing the response of RTF/EMS to a terrorist-related and mass causality incident, which protocol is known as SOP 56 which has been reviewed and approved by the Cape May County Chiefs' of Police Association, the Cape May County Prosecutor, the County Office of Emergency Management and other similar such entities or agencies; and
