Special events sponsored solely by the Borough of Stone Harbor are exempt from the payment of the fee for special event permit. Such special events shall be governed by applicable Borough policies. Borough Council retains the discretion to waive any provision of this chapter where deemed appropriate in the sole discretion of the Borough Council.
